ACTIVITY 1 **PAIRS > WHOLE CLASS**

Listen and check if you were right.

AFTER LISTENING

There's many things I wish I didn't do.

I wish / if only can be used to express regrets.

When after these expressions we use past simple, we talk about the present.

Examples:

I wish/If only I could fly. = I can't fly and I regret it.

I wish/If only had a lot of money. = I haven't got a lot of money and I regret it.

When after these expressions we use past perfect, we talk about the past.

Examples:

I wish/If only I hadn't said that. = I said that in the past and now I regret it.

I wish/If only hadn't hurt you. = I hurt you in the past and now I regret it.

ACTIVITY 4

Express regrets about the situations presented below. Start sentences with I wish or If only

1. You have no job. ... **I wish I had a job.**
2. You did not go to university. ... **I wish I had gone to university.**
3. You did not report the theft to the police. ... **I wish I had reported the theft to the police.**
4. Your sister visits you very rarely. ... **I wish my sister visited me more often.**
5. Your team lost the match. ... **I wish my team hadn't lost the match.**
6. You went to bed late last night. ... **I wish I had gone to bed earlier.**
7. You smoke. ... **I wish I didn't smoke.**
8. You do sport very rarely **I wish I did sport more often.**
