He was a journalist for the newspaper *The Huddersfield Daily Examiner* with her. Adrian Sudbury had a blog to explain his illness. The illness is very dangerous because it destroys your muscles and tires the body...

Doctors detect the illness with blood. The leukaemia can be in everybody. There is a treatment to slow down leukaemia. You can have chemotherapy or radiotherapy. If it doesn't work, you must take bone marrow cells from healthy people and inject them to the sick person.

Adrian Sudbury was born on July 15th 1981 and died of leukaemia on August 20th 2008. He caught leukaemia 2 years ago. He was hard-working and ambitious. He liked sports (kick boxing), writing and reading. Adrian met Katie 5 years ago when she started to work with him for the *Examiner*. She enjoyed him a lot and she even took up the association when he died. Adrian Sudbury used to be the boss of the association to fight against leukaemia and he created his blog to tell people about his life with leukaemia. When he died, Katie collected the articles from the blog in a book designed to be sold to collect money for the association. We now wish she had a lot of money for the association and more and more donors everyday !!!
